



The Taoyuan Branch of Chang Gung Hospital, is the single largest medical facility in the world developed on a 17.5ha site by Formosa Plastics, owners of a number of private hospitals in Taiwan. The gross GFA of the building is 280,000m<sup>2</sup>. McGregor Coxall were commissioned for site planning, design, documentation and site review of the entire external works including green roofs. The facility has approximately 3000 beds servicing both day surgery and long stay patients. The site program was conceived from the psychological notion that landscape is important in the healing process for patients. Design components included extensive roof gardens, an outdoor cafe, interactive water features, walking trails, sun dial, tea gardens and outdoor art/craft workshop plazas. All non potable water for the project is supplied through a black water treatment plant. The building is designed to accommodate social and medical
